THE CHARLOTTE HARBOR NATIONAL ESTUARY PROGRAM partners, including citizens, elected officials, resource managers and commercial and recreational resource users, have been hard at work protecting the greater Charlotte Harbor estuarine system from Venice in Sarasota County to Bonita Springs in Lee County to Winter Haven in Polk County. The CHNEP partners assessed the progress made and reassessed the problems, priorities and actions required to protect the greater Charlotte Harbor estuarine system. The results appear in the CHNEP 2008 *Comprehensive Conservation and Management Plan*.

CLIMATE-READY ESTUARIES — The southwest Florida shoreline is susceptible to climate change so the CHNEP is helping communities understand and adapt by assisting local decision-makers and resource managers. Six national estuary programs received grants from the U.S. EPA in an effort to build local ability to adapt to climate change.
