## CHNEP GRANTS

Three types of grants are available to help you protect the natural environment. Public Outreach Grants (up to \$3,000, applications due September 2) and Research and Restoration Partners Grants (up to \$20,000 with 50% matching funds, proposals due September 17) are available once a year. Small micro-grants of up to \$250 for outreach projects are available year round. These grants are open to anyone — individuals, community groups, volunteers, service organizations, businesses, government agencies and educational entities — but must occur within the CHNEP study area.
