THE CHARLOTTE HARBOR NATIONAL ESTUARY PROGRAM used a cooperative decision-making process based on sound science to develop a *Comprehensive Conservation and Management Plan (CCMP)*. The plan identifies the region's priority environmental issues — water quality, hydrology (water flow), fish and wildlife habitat loss and stewardship — and actions to solve them. The CCMP was accepted in 2001, which marked the beginning of action to restore and protect our estuaries and watersheds, and updated in 2008.
